Our meeting in the Archive on **4 July** was informative and social, a small crowd but great atmosphere.


Many thanks to our **DCS Secretary, Mara Vitasovich,** who gave a wonderful talk to an appreciative audience at our **June** meeting.

## August 2024 Meeting David Tolich

## 2.00 pm Sunday 4 August 2024 in the Members' Lounge

Speaker **David Tolich** will make an illustrated presentation on the subject of early Croatian /Maori relationships. Many of the early Dalmatians settled, some with mail-order brides, others with Maori women and a unique community was born.

In 1892, Croatian Andrija Kleskovic married his Maori Princess Erina Kaaka at St Saviour's Church in Kaitaia in the far north of New Zealand. The couple had 13 children over an 18 year period.


